# Ice Dragon Beanie

## **Supplies**

- 1 skein Manos del Uruguay Allegria Grande
- 1 SZ 6 16" Circular Needles
- 1 SZ 8 Circular Needles
- 1 set SZ 8 double pointed needles
- 1 stitch marker
- 1 Tapestry Needle

### Gauge

Approx 5sts I + 1" and 7-8 rows = 1" 8" inches by approx. 19" inches aroun

## **Abbreviations**

St stitch
Sts stitches
YO yarn over
K knit
P purl
K2tog knit 2 together
Dp Double pointed needles

#### **Directions:**

Using SZ 6 16" circular needles, cast on 104 stiches. Join with a slip stitch and place marker.

K2, P2 all across to create a 2x2 rib stitch. Repeat until ribbing measures 1 1/2"

Change to SZ 8 16" circulars.

Knit a row all around to marker.

#### Pattern:

Row 1 of Pattern: Knit all around to marker.

Row 2 of Pattern: K2, YO, K2, pass YO over 2 sts and off needle. Repeat from \* to \* to end of

round.

Row 3 of Pattern: Knit all the way around

Row 4 of Pattern: YO, K2, Pass YO over 2 sts and off the needle, K2 \*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of

round

Repeat these 4 rows until hat measures 6".

Row 5: Knit all around to marker

Row 6: \*Knit 6, K2tog\* repeat from \* to \* to end of row.

Row 7: \*Knit 5, K2tog\* repeat from \* to \* to end of row.

Row 8: Knit all around.

Row 9: \*Knit 4, K2tog" repeat from \* to \*to end of row

Row 10 Knit all around.

Row 11: \*Knit 3, K2tog\* repeat rom \* to\* to end of row

Row 12: \*Knit all around

\*\*Note: Change to SZ 8 double pointed needles any time you need to.

Row 13: \*K2, K2tog" repeat from \* to \*to end of row

Row 14: K2tog all around. You should have 13 sts on the dp's.

Cut about a 6" tail and using a tapestry needle, take the sts off the needles and draw closed.

Weave in ends.
